**NAR STRATEGY COMMITTEE**

**Statement of Purpose**

NAR Strategy Committee is to:

1. Identify, recruit and mentor Louisiana REALTORS® and Louisiana REALTOR® Executives for leadership positions within the National Association of REALTORS®.
2. Recommend support of issues or candidates for NAR office to the LR Executive Committee.
3. Act in an advisory capacity to LR Executive Committee when requested, regarding NAR issues, policies or other concerns.
4. Assist in recommendation of LR members aspiring to NAR positions.

**Composition**

The LR Executive Committee shall appoint a committee with an approximate total of 3 members. The chairman shall be named by the LR Executive Committee. Included in the foregoing shall be the following appointments:

1. LR President
2. LR President-Elect
3. LR Secretary-Treasurer
4. The NAR Regional Vice President when from Louisiana
5. The Nar Regional Vice President-Elect/Nominee when from Louisiana
6. RPAC Trustee when from Louisiana
7. LR members who are appointed NAR Vice-President of Committees or Vice-President of Government Affairs, if any
8. At Large member as determined by the Executive Committee
9. Any Past Presidents involved in leadership positions at NAR
10. A local board Association Executive

NAR Committee Liaisons should be considered for an At-Large position. Terms are for a period of one year but with no term limits.

At Executive Committee discretion, upon any endorsement of NAR Officers, letters shall be sent to the LR NAR Directors to notify them of that endorsement.

## **Duties/Activities/Guidelines**

1. Advise and consult with LR Executive Committee regarding all NAR appointments when feasible.
2. Make recommendations as to NAR Officers and Candidates for NAR office who should be invited for LR visits – invitations shall be extended by the LR Executives Committee with arrangements and administration handled by the staff in coordination with the Chair of the Strategy Committee.
3. Make recommendations to the Texas NAR Directors Caucus with respect to issues, policies and elections within Region 10 when requested by TAR Leadership Team.
4. Interview announced NAR candidates and/or NAR aspirants and make recommendations to the LR Executive Committee regarding endorsements or possible future endorsements: All interviews shall be approved by the LR Executive Committee.
5. Oversee an ongoing program and educational forum for LR members on “How and Why to Get Involved at NAR” with the forum to be regularly held at LR meetings.
6. Assist in recruiting, advising and mentoring members to serve on NAR Committees as well as Board of Directors.
7. Provide support and mentoring opportunities for LR members in their advancement at NAR. Mentors may be from LR and/or other sources.
8. Identify key committees and task forces where our members need to serve in order to achieve the necessary recognition.
9. Work with key local association leadership encouraging their participation in achieving our NAR objective by assisting with the identification of potential interested leaders and encouraging locals to consider involvement beyond serving as an NAR Director and become involved in the committee and task force process.
10. Work with all associations in an effort to achieve the goal of increasing the strength of our state association within the NAR family.
